- 2. Music practices of artists from culturally diverse backgrounds that are connected to their cultures of origin

Cultural Arts Collective recommends that national <u>funding</u> is needed to support:

- 1. New contemporary music that includes our many cultures in a culturally appropriate way
- 2. Recording of this cutting edge music
- 3. Marketing/brand development and advocating for the dynamic and innovative new music that is being created, that can be a world leader in contemporary music

Cultural Arts Collective believes that with proper acknowledgement and support of our culturally diverse music industry that this under represented Industry could be:

- A force for social inclusion
- an economic powerhouse
- world leader in contemporary music
