Borrowing institutions approved under the *Protection of Cultural Objects on Loan Act 2013* (the Act) are required to report annually by providing information on objects that have been or are proposed to be imported into Australia for temporary public exhibition and protected under Part 2 of the Act.

Annual reports for the preceding financial year are due to the Minister for the Arts by 31 October each year. Reports should be submitted to the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts by no later than **Wednesday 4 October 2023**.

Annual reports (including any attachments) should be submitted via the **SmartyGrants platform**. The Program Officer will send an email to each organisation required to submit an annual report, with instructions about the annual report form.
