Cultural Funding by Government — 2017–18

Victorian Government

The estimate of expenditure funded by the Victorian Government in 2017–18 for cultural activities was **\$547.1m**. This represented an increase of 11% or \$54.5m from 2016–17.


- Recurrent expenses accounted for 82% (\$447.6m) of funded cultural expenditure.
- Capital expenditure was \$99.5m, and the largest three categories were Libraries (\$44.1m), Other museums and cultural heritage (\$22.4m) and Performing art venues (\$18.4m).
- > The estimate of per person cultural funding was \$85.67.

Funds on Heritage activities rose 11% (or \$29.6m) to \$294.0m.

This increase was driven by expenditure on the categories of *Libraries* (\uparrow \$27.2m) and *Art Museums* (\uparrow \$7.3m). Increases were offset by a fall in *Other museums and cultural heritage* (\downarrow \$6m).

Over one-third (44%) of Heritage funds were spent on Libraries (\$128.0m).

Funds for Arts activities rose 11% (or \$24.9m) to \$253.1m.

Three main contributors to this movement were *Performing arts venues* \uparrow \$7.4m, *Film and video production and distribution* \uparrow \$6.6m, and *Design* \uparrow \$5.1m. Conversely, funding for *Cross-art form* dropped by \$3.0m due to a reduction in capital expenditure.




Figure 2. Victorian Government arts expenditure, by selected categories

The main categories of Arts activities funding were:

- Performing arts venues—\$47.0m
- Arts education—\$45.9m
- Film and video production and distribution—\$34.6m
- Cross-art form—\$33.5m
- Music—\$10.9m.

Recurrent expenditure increased 4% (or \$16.4m) to \$447.6m.

The largest recurrent expenditure was for *Libraries*, \$83.9m, followed by *Other museums and cultural heritage* (\$63.3m).
